YRs **Alice Krasno - Elite III** won the PP PSG - **Emily Richards** - Odwig was 6th in the Friday evening PSG. UNICORN NATIONAL TRAINING CLINICS

Our Winter & Spring series of Training Clinics were brilliant. First class Trainers have put everything into long days at Unicorn, with many riders benefitting from their input. The facilities at the Unicorn are the very best in the country. However we have been affected by the recession. It is proving very difficult to maintain the level of Clinics and remain solvent. For almost 8 years we have given superior training and facilities. This has not been easy and over the past year has become even more challenging.

Sadly I have cancelled the 2011 Unicorn September Viewing & Training Weekend.

In September 2010 the BD National Squads Viewing happened on the same date -and many riders I had thought would train with us again, did not. U21s UK can no longer afford to book Trainers & venues and cancel. Twice we paid Trainers & Facilities a % of costs due to late cancellations when Clinics did not run. This came from funds - but due to the recession + lower membership, we cannot again! Options No more Training! Or limit Unicorn to just 4 Clinics per Season - October – December – February - May. Travel is obviously a huge problem now with diesel costs so high this affects everyone.

MARLTON U25s DRESSAGE FESTIVAL 2011 - Wicklow, Southern Ireland.

U21s UK were not able to raise Teams this year – the cost was prohibitive – with a bill for over £2,000 per family taking part. We had very few applicants due to this. I know some riders were disappointed and I am sorry – but hopefully those who are really keen will be included in their Regional Byrds Teams for the Home International which will take place at Rowallan near Glasgow in Scotland 25th – 27th July. Good Luck.

10th & FINAL SUMMER CHAMPIONSHIPS ADDINGTON EC 23-24 JULY.
