It is fantastic that you all WON at least 2 Qualifying Tests with over 65% to qualify for your place at the Regionals.

It is fantastic that you either WON or were in the top 2 or 3 at the Regionals. Some of you had very good marks which gained you a Wild Card, taking you through to The British Dressage National Championships 2010.

I was at the Nationals at Stoneleigh for 3 of the 4 days of competitions, and I think you were some of very few younger riders taking part this year.

It would have been brilliant, a bit of a film star ending, if you could all have been Champions. However, even if you were not a Champion this year – you will, I am sure, be back next year to try again.

I also witnessed brilliant riding, when things were not going as expected. In the PSG - after a really amazing build up – with every top result from this year announced – Spring Pascal over- reacted to the electric atmosphere. Sam Thurman Baker showed what a totally professional rider she is – by coaxing him through the test and remaining calm. She even managed to smile to her mum, and pat Pascal as they returned through the archway.

It is so easy to enjoy the `Winning` - it is so difficult to remain totally professional when it has gone so publicly wrong. Congratulations to Sam, the leading British Junior rider 2010 – and already beginning a training programme towards a place at the 2011 Junior Europeans.
